### CALL FOR PAPERS

Abidjan – Côte d'Ivoire, March 21 and 22, 2019

***“Development public policy in Sub-Saharan African Countries”***

**Submission deadline for contributions: 15 November 2018**

The workshop aims at gathering economics analysis on various aspects of public policies in Sub-Saharan Africa. A diversity of approaches (theoretical and/or empirical, quantitative and/or qualitative) is welcome. The scope of the workshop includes the following themes:

- Sectorial public policy: education, poverty, inequality, health, gender, security
- Public policy and employment
- The territorial dimensions of public policy
- Ways of funding public policy (mobilization of internal fiscal resources, choice of fiscal instruments, untapped fiscal sources)

We invite submissions, preferably of complete articles even if only draft versions, or possibly a summary of at least two pages which includes the method, bibliography, keywords, based on methods from economics or other social sciences. Selection criteria will be rigorous with respect to methodological soundness, article's specific contribution in terms of the existing literature and accordance with the themes of the workshop.
