Brazzaville – République du Congo, September 28 and 29, 2020

“Development public policies in Sub-Saharan African Countries”

Submission deadline for contributions: 31 May 2020

The workshop aims at gathering economics analysis on various aspects of public policies in Sub-Saharan Africa. A diversity of approaches (theoretical and/or empirical, quantitative and/or qualitative) is welcome. The scope of the workshop includes the following themes:

- Ways of funding public policy (mobilization of internal fiscal resources, choice of fiscal instruments, untapped fiscal sources)
- Public finances
- Sectorial public policy: education, poverty, inequality, health, gender, security
- The territorial dimensions of public policies

We invite submissions, preferably of complete articles even if only draft versions, or possibly a summary of at least two pages which includes the method, bibliography, keywords, based on methods from economics or other social sciences. Selection criteria will be rigorous with respect to methodological soundness, article’s specific contribution in terms of the existing literature and accordance with the themes of the workshop.
